



CONTEST TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PARTICIPATION IN THIS CONTEST CONSTITUTES YOUR FULL AND UNCONDITIONAL AGREEMENT TO AND ACCEPTANCE OF THESE CONTEST TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

Prospera Credit Union ("Prospera", "we") is pleased to present the *The \$20k Giveaway* (the "Contest"). The Contest is governed by the terms and conditions (the "Rules") set out below. By entering the Contest, you agree to abide by the Rules and decisions of Prospera, which will be final. You also agree to comply with all applicable laws. The Contest is void where prohibited or restricted by law. No purchase necessary. Entry details are also available at: https://www.prospera.ca/the-20k-giveaway

- 1. **Contest Period:** The Contest runs from 9:00 am PST Monday, October 15th, 2024 to 4:00 pm PST on Saturday, December 21st, 2024 (the "**Contest Period**"). Prospera Credit Union employees will be the sole determinant of the entry time for all Contest participants.
- 2. **Contest Prizes:** There are six (6) prizes to be won in this Contest, consisting of: one (1) grand prize of a \$20,000 1-year non-redeemable term deposit, and five (5) \$1,000 1-year cashable term deposits, fully redeemable with interest after 30 days of the initial investment. Prizes are not eligible for substitution, are non-transferrable, and may not be redeemed for cash or credit. All prizes must be accepted as awarded. Chances of winning are dependent on the number of eligible entries received. Prospera reserves the right, in the event that any prize or any component of any prize cannot be awarded as described for any reason, to substitute another prize or component of a prize of equal or greater value, including a cash award. Limit of one prize per person.
- 3. **Award of Prizes:** Six random draws will be held for the Prizes on Wednesday, January 15th, 2025. Odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received during the Contest Period.
- 4. **How to Enter:** No purchase is necessary. There are two ways to enter the Contest:
 - a. To enter the Contest, entrants must book and attend a wealth investment discussion appointment with an Aviso Wealth representative at Prospera Credit Union during the Contest Period at a branch of their choosing. Potential entrants may only have one (1) entry for the Contest and can earn that entry online, in branch or by telephone, as follows:
 - i. Online: Proceed to the booking page prospera.coconutcalendar.com/service) to book an investment review appointment with an Aviso Wealth representative at Prospera Credit union.





- Choose "Financial Planning & Advice" and then select "The 20k Giveaway" as the appointment type.
- ii. In Branch: Visit any Prospera Credit Union branch and talk to a branch representative to book an investment review appointment.
- iii. Telephone Call: Call 1-888-440-4480 to book an investment review appointment.

Alternatively, you may mail in a letter or postcard with the name of the Contest, your first and last name, and your email address, to: Prospera Credit Union – Surrey Corporate Office 1900 - 13450 102 Avenue, Surrey, BC V3T 5Y1. All such entries must be received by Prospera during the Contest Period.

5. Eligibility

- a. To enter and be eligible to win, you must: (a) be a legal resident of British Columbia at the time of entry; (b) have reached the age of majority at time of entry; and (c) not be an employee of Prospera or its affiliated companies, agents, Contest administrators, or advertising promotional agencies.
- b. By participating in this Contest, you acknowledge compliance with, and agree to be bound by, these Rules. If you do not comply with any of the Rules, you may be subject to disqualification by Prospera, in Prospera's sole discretion.
- c. Any entries received after the Contest Period will not be eligible. If more than one entry is received per person, only the first such entry received will be eligible. Submissions through groups and/or charities will not be accepted. Proof of transmission (for example, screenshots or captures) does not constitute proof of entry or receipt of an entry. If an entry is received from an entrant who has not provided a valid email address, the entry received will be deemed ineligible. In the event of a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, the authorized account holder of the email account will be deemed to be the entrant. "Authorized account holder" of an e-mail address is the natural person in whose name the e-mail address has been issued. A selected entrant may be asked to provide Prospera with proof that the selected entrant is the authorized account holder of the e-mail address associated with the selected entry. If a dispute cannot be resolved, Prospera may deem the entry ineligible. Entries generated by script, macro, or other automated means are void at Prospera's discretion.
- **6. Contact Information:** By entering the Contest, each entrant consents to Prospera collecting, using and disclosing the entrant's personal information for the purposes of administering the Contest, publicizing a list of winners, and (unless the contestant opts out) promoting the Contest and any future contests and any of Prospera's products and services, in accordance with Prospera's Privacy Code, which is online at https://www.prospera.ca/Policies/Privacy+policy or can be found at any Prospera Credit Union branch. administration of this Contest. Under no circumstances will Prospera sell or give lists of our Contest entrants to others outside of the administration of this Contest and as described in these Rules, except as required by law. All entries become the property of Prospera and none will be returned. Prospera is not obligated to enter into any correspondence except with the selected entrant.

- 7. **Amendment:** Prospera reserves the right to terminate or amend this Contest at any time and in any way, without prior notice to entrants. Without limiting the foregoing, if for any reason Prospera cannot run the Contest as planned (including as a result of bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, infection by computer virus or any other cause that corrupts, impairs or affects the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of the Contest), Prospera may cancel, modify, extend, or suspend the Contest. In that event, Prospera may award prizes at random from among the eligible entries received up to the time of the impairment, or award no prizes.
- 8. **Disqualification:** Prospera may disqualify any individual who attempts to, is suspected of attempting to, or does, in each case as determined in Prospera's discretion: (1) tamper with or in any way corrupt the entry or voting process (including by using robotic, automatic, programmed, or otherwise illicit means to enter the Contest, or any other methods not authorized by these Rules); (2) undermine the legitimate operation of the Contest by cheating, hacking, deception, or other unfair practices; (3) annoy, abuse, threaten, or harass any other entrants or Prospera representatives; or (4) submit an entry with false or incomplete information.
- 9. Disclaimer: Prospera will not be responsible for: (1) incorrect or inaccurate transcription of entry information or late, lost, incomplete, misdirected entries, or entries received through impermissible or illegitimate channels; (2) technical failures of any kind, including the malfunctioning of any telephone, computer, network, hardware, or software; (3) the unavailability or inaccessibility of any service; (4) unauthorized human intervention in any part of the entry process or the Contest; (5) electronic or human error which may occur in the administration of the Contest or the processing of entries; (6) typographical errors; (7) the failure for any reason whatsoever of a selected entrant to receive notification of selection or for Prospera to receive a selected entrant's response; or (8) any injury or damage to persons or property, including your computer, which may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from your participation in the Contest or from downloading any material from Prospera's website. Prospera will not be liable to you for any indirect, special, consequential, or punitive damages in connection with the Contest or these Rules.
- 10. **Winner Verification:** The potential winner is subject to verification by Prospera Credit Union, including proof of identity by government issues identification and eligibility. The potential winner way me contacted via email address and/or phone provided. If contacted,

the potential winner must respond within five days. Failure to respond within five days of notification, return of email notification as undeliverable, or failure to comply with these Contest Rules, will result in disqualification.

11. **To Claim a Prize:** In order to be declared a winner, the selected entrant must have complied with, and remain fully in compliance with, these Rules, and must correctly answer, without assistance of any kind, a time-limited mathematical skill-testing question posed by telephone at a mutually convenient time. If the entrant's answer to the skill-testing question is incorrect or they do not meet the eligibility criteria, they will be disqualified and another entrant will be randomly selected from all eligible entries until such time as all winners are confirmed or there are no more eligible entries, whichever comes first.

In order to be declared a winner, the selected entrant must also sign and deliver to Prospera a standard declaration of eligibility and release form, which will include a declaration of the selected entrant's compliance with these Rules, acceptance of the prize as awarded, a publicity release, a liability release, an indemnity, and any other documentation that Prospera may reasonably require (the "Release Form"). - 12. APPLICABLE LAW; ENFORCEABILITY: The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, and municipal laws and regulations. Any dispute will be adjudicated by the courts sitting in Vancouver, British Columbia. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of these Rules will not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision. In the event that any provision is determined to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable or illegal, these Rules will otherwise remain in effect and will be construed in accordance with their terms as if the invalid or illegal provision were not included.
- 13. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY: All intellectual property, including but not limited to trademarks, logos, designs, promotional materials, web pages, source codes, images, drawings, illustrations, slogans, and representations are owned by Prospera. All rights reserved. Unauthorized copying or use of any of Prospera's intellectual property without the prior express written consent of Prospera is strictly prohibited.





- 14. CONFLICTS / DISCREPANCIES: In the event of a conflict between any Contest details contained in these Rules and any Contest details contained in Contest advertising materials, the details of the Contest as set out in these Rules will govern.
- 15. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS: By entering the Contest, each entrant:
 - **a.** agrees to abide by the Rules, and all decisions of Prospera with respect to all aspects of the Contest, which are final; and
 - **b.** releases, and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless, Prospera and its employees, directors, officers, members, affiliates, and agents from any and all damages, injuries, claims, causes of actions, or losses of any kind (including actual legal fees and expenses) arising from or related to: (i) the entrant's failure to comply with any of these Rules; (ii) any misrepresentation the entrant makes under these Rules or otherwise to Prospera; or (iii) the entrant's participation in the Contest or use of any prize received.
